

This warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state or country to country.












Door Assembly in Positions 2,3 & 4











Step 1.Remove PC1E,PC2E,RFRE,RF3E & RF4E











Step 7. Support the Roof Panel (R2E&R5E) by using an appropriate support to avoid the structure from collapsing.




Step 8.Remove Roof Structure (TS1E,TC7E & TC8E)




Step 9.Remove S2 From TC5E & TC6E









