

Instructions are supplied in this manual and contain all appropriate information for your building model. Review all instructions before you begin. During assembly, follow the step sequence carefully for correct results


Parts

Check to be sure that you have all the necessary parts for the building.

Watch the weather:


Please be sure the day you select for installation is dry and calm.


DO NOT attempt to assemble your shed in windy weather because of risk of damage to panels, or personal injury. Be careful of wet or muddy ground.

Teamwork:

Whenever possible, two or more people should work together to assemble the building. One person can position parts or panels while the other is able to handle the fasteners and the tools.







Insert the other end of W2 and W3 into corner guard W4.

Connect W1 and W2 with F2 screw at each corner.

Assemble W5 and W6







Push the parts 5# and 2# into the groove of S2L/R.

Insert the hump on the part S3R and S3L into the circled groove of W1.

Push the parts 2# and 5# into the groove of S3R/L.





Maintenance:

1.Please prevent adding any increased weight to the product.

PC Panel Maintenance:

- 1. Be careful not to have a sharp object touch the film as it may scratch.
- 2.Clean films regularly to keep the light transmittance as clear as possible.
- 3. The boards/panels have flame retardant polycarbonate material applied to them and is recommended to keep away from fire to avoid softening or deformation.

Frame Maintenance:

1. The frames are made of aluminum alloy structure. If white spots or dirt is shown, please wipe with a wet cloth. White spots are normal in a wet/warm environment.

Weather Protection:

- 1.WARNING: If there is lightening, do not stay in or under the product. The frames is conductive, and may cause serious damage.
- 2. When wind power reaches 40mph or above, you may need to set up defense equipment and fix the greenhouse wall.
- 3. During snowy months, please remove any snow from greenhouse to avoid any walls or roofs from collapsing.

Outdoor Products

1-Year Limited Warranty Program

For a period of one (1) year after purchase, Hanover ("Manufacturer") will either repair or replace defective components in accordance with this Limited Warranty. This warranty is between Manufacturer and the original purchaser and is valid only when accompanied by the original purchaser's sales receipt showing original date of purchase and location of purchase. Replacements under this warranty revert back to the date of original purchase for future warranty.

Manufacturer or its authorized dealer can accept or reject warranty claims based on its findings. This warranty applies in normal residential use only and is not intended for commercial use. Manufacturer can make substitutions as required of materials, components, and sub-components of comparable value and utility. This warranty is limited to product repair or replacement (to be determined solely by Manufacturer). Warranty return is limited to only the single affected component.

This warranty covers only manufacturing defects and does not cover normal wear and tear, damage due to acts of nature, abuse or misuse, including chemical damage from suntan oil or other chemicals, exposure to extreme heat or cold, abrasion or excessive weight. This product is intended to be used in standard installations only. This warranty is invalid if the product is not used for intended purpose. Manufacturer disclaims liability for any aspect of installation and any inconvenience caused by a defective part of a component.

Certain items are not covered by this warranty. These include, but are not limited to the following:
