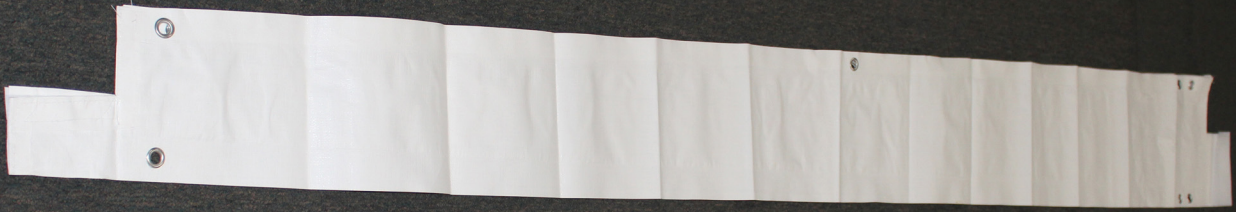




RAIN GUTTER INSTRUCTIONS



Includes:

1 - 10' Rain Gutter

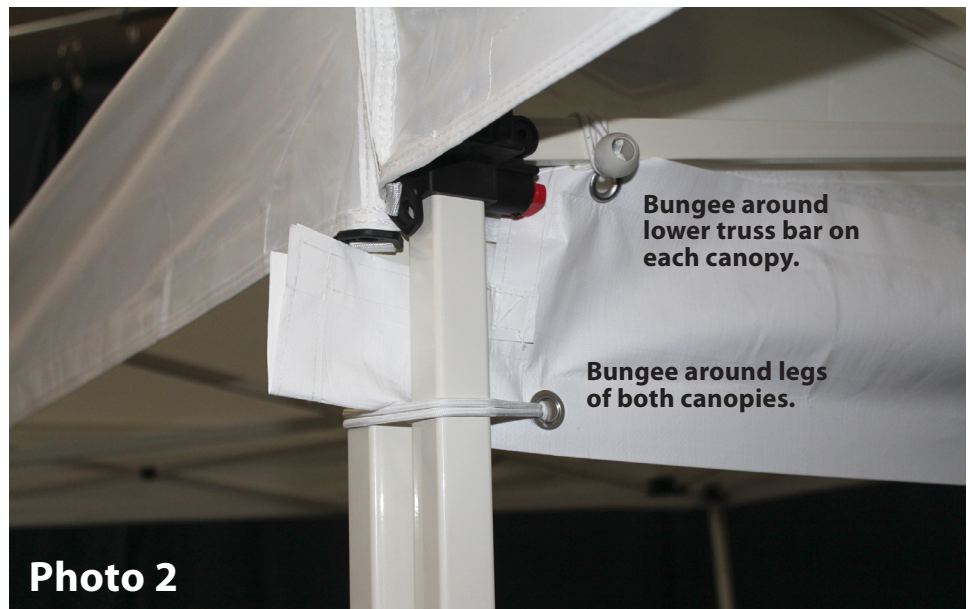
10 - White Ball Bungee Straps

For use on 10'x10' or the 10' sides of 2 straight leg instant pop up canopies.

- 1) Decide which end you'd like the water to run off at. This is where the wider end of the rain gutter will be installed. (Photo 1)



- 2) Open up rain gutter in form of a "V" under the valances of both side by side canopies. Attach 2 ball bungees - 1 around each truss bar of both canopies through the upper grommets. Next, pull 1 bungee cord thru grommet, wrap around the two legs and fasten the strap around the ball. Make sure spout flap is sticking out between the 2 legs. (Photo 2)



- 3) Do the same for the other end of the rain gutter. Using the grommet that is closest to the legs, Attach 2 ball bungees - 1 around each truss bar of both canopies through the upper grommets. Next, pull 1 bungee cord thru grommet, wrap around the two legs and fasten the strap around the ball. Make sure spout flap is sticking out between the 2 legs. This is the end that the water will flow out of. (Photo 3)



- 4) Now attach a ball bungee at the center around each lower truss bar of both canopies. (Photo 4)



- 5) Once finished this is what the attached rain gutter will look like. (Photo 5)

WARRANTY
